
- Interkulturelle Kenntnisse sammeln auch <u>ohne</u> Auslandsaufenthalt u. vor der Abreise

- Verhandlungsgeschick


• elearning/blended learning = selbstbestimmtes Lernen H: Gruppenarbeit erschwert durch mangelnde Technologie
